

Old Settlers Rules for Off-Road Vehicles

Golf Carts & ATVs will be allowed from 4:00pm on Friday, Aug. 12th until 6:00pm on Sunday, Aug. 14th.

1. All vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver 16 years old or older.
2. All vehicles must abide by all rules of the road. Stopping at all stop signs, speeding and DUI will be strictly enforced.
3. Only the amount of passengers that the vehicle is designed to carry will be allowed to ride on vehicle
4. No low riding vehicles (such as go-karts). They are not visible due to the low height to the ground.
5. If the ATV or UTV does not have a windshield, you must have eye protection.
6. Any ATV or UTV that is not equipped with a roll cage and has a driver or passenger under the age of 18, must wear a helmet.
7. All vehicles driven after dark must have working headlights and taillights.

If you are found to be violating any of these rules you may be asked to park your vehicle for the rest of the weekend. If you continue to use the vehicle, it will be subject to impound for the remainder of the weekend.

These rules are in place to ensure everyone can enjoy this privilege the City Council grants once a year. However, we still have the duty to make sure everyone operates the vehicles safely.

If you have any questions regarding the rules or regulations set forth, please make sure you get them clarified prior to operating your off-road vehicle.
